Prayer in the present petition is for directing respondent No.4 to pay compensation to the petitioner for having violated her fundamental rights.

The matter was admitted by this Court vide order dated 14.09.2000. Since there was no representation on behalf of the petitioner when the matter was taken up for hearing, the Registry was directed to inform the respective parties about the listing of the case vide order dated 06.05.2019. It has been reported by the Registry that the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respective parties have been informed but the notice issued to the petitioner has been received back with a report that does not reside at the given address. Hence, the address of the petitioner is no more known and the learned counsel appearing on her behalf has chosen not to appear in the matter.

Under the given circumstances this Court is left with no option but to assume that the petitioner is no more interested in pursuing the present writ petition.

Dismissed for non-prosecution.

Liberty is however granted to the petitioner to seek revival of the present petition in case any cause of action still survives.
