1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 10.10.2023 passed in CWP-1472-2020.
2. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 10.10.2023 passed in CWP-1472-2020 has since been complied with and representation of the petitioner has been decided by passing the speaking order.
3. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
