The instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No.58, dated 03.08.2022, under Sections 22(c) and 29 of NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Sadar Budhlada, District Mansa.

This Court vide order dated 08.02.2024, while issuing notice of motion, granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner, subject to his joining the investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to the order dated 08.02.2024, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Jaskaran Singh submits that neither any recovery has been effected from the possession of the petitioner nor is to be effected from him.

In the light of the statement made by learned State counsel, the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required at this stage.

In view of the above, the order dated 08.02.2024 is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed off.
