1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondent for disobedience of the order dated 26.07.2022 passed by this Court in CWP-8320-2022.
2. There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.
3. Compliance report on behalf of respondent filed by learned State counsel today in the Court is taken on record. Learned State counsel has submitted that order dated 26.07.2022 passed in CWP-8320-2022 has been complied with and the petitioner has been allowed to join as Extension Lecturer at Government College for Women, Sonipat. Even, the joining order dated 07.11.2023 has already been issued, vide Annexure R-1 annexed with the compliance report.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-addressed, she would be at liberty to raise the same in any alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
