Prayer in the present petition under Section 439 of Code of Criminal Procedure is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 351 dated 09.11.2004 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of IPC at Police Station Civil Lines, Amritsar, District Amritsar.

2. Counsel for the petitioners submits that both the petitioners are senior citizens and are in custody since 06.12.2023. It is further submitted that the petitioners were falsely implicated in the present case but now compromise has been effected and the entire disputed amount has been paid to the complainant by the daughter of the petitioners. So, prayer is made that the petitioners be released on regular bail.

4. Mr. Inderjeet Singh Ladher, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State and on instructions from ASI Gurmeet Singh has not disputed the fact that matter stands compromised between the parties and entire payment has been made by the petitioners through their daughter to

5. In light of the fact that the entire disputed payment is already made by the petitioners, no purpose is going to be served by detaining the petitioners in custody for any longer period.

6. In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the petitioners are ordered to be released on regular bail subject to their furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.
