SANJIV BERRY, J.(ORAL)

1. The instant petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. has been filed by the petitioner for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to not to interfere in the life of the petitioner, especially respondent No.3, who is harassing and threatening the petitioner.

2. It is, *inter alia*, contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is innocent and was involved only in one case i.e. FIR No.09 dated 19.03.2013 registered under Sections 307 and 34 of IPC; Sections 21 and 29 of NDPS Act and Section 25 of Arms Act at P.S. Khem Karan, District Tarn Taran, wherein he was acquitted on 20.11.2017 and thereafter he is not involved in any criminal activity but the police of Police Station Khem Karan, District Tarn Taran, is harassing by calling him to police station repeatedly and the petitioner, in this regard, moved representation dated 25.01.2024 (Annexure P-2) to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, District Tarn Taran, but till date no action thereon has been taken. He submits that the petitioner will be satisfied if

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appropriate directions are given to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, District Tarn Taran, to consider and dispose of the representation dated 25.01.2024 (Annexure P-2) in accordance with law in an expeditious manner.

3. Notice of motion.
4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Sarabjit Singh Cheema, DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.
5. After hearing the respective submissions and also the averments made in the petition by learned counsel for the petitioner, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, District Tarn Taran, to consider and dispose of the representation dated 25.01.2024 (Annexure P-2) moved by the petitioner in accordance with law in an expeditious manner and the decision so taken be also intimated to the petitioner as well.
6. Disposed of.
7. It is made clear that anything contained hereinabove shall not be construed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
