NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of certiorari, quashing the order dated 21.02.1998 (Annexure P-4), whereby the petitioner has been retired from service.
2. There was no representation on behalf of the petitioner on the last date of hearing i.e. 17.07.2024 and notice was ordered to be issued to Ms. Vanita Sapra Kataria, Advocate, counsel for the petitioner for today.
3. As per office report, letter dated 26.07.2024 has been served upon the counsel for the petitioner. However, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.
4. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the petitioner has retired from service on attaining the age of superannuation on 22.02.1998 on completion of 28 years of service.
5. In this view of the matter, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to revive the same in case any cause still survives.
