NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of certiorari, quashing the order dated 08.10.1998 (Annexure P-11) and subsequent notices dated 05.04.1999, 29.04.1999 and 26.07.1999 (Annexure P-14, P-15 & P-17), whereby respondent No.2 has directed the petitioner to reinstate respondent No.3 and to pay him back wages.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite his best efforts, he has not been able to get further instructions from the petitioner.
3. In this view of the matter, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to revive the same in case any cause still survives.
