1. The jurisdiction of this Court under Section 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been invoked for issuance of a Writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for appointment of a Warrant Officer for the release of the detenues namely Sukhwinder Kaur @ Sukhnoor Kaur (wife of the petitioner) and minor child Satvir Singh (son of the petitioner), who are stated to be in illegal confinement of respondent No.7.
2. In compliance of the order dated 21.02.2024, a status report by way of an affidavit dated 13.03.2024 of Varun Sharma, IPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala has been filed, which is taken on record. Copy thereof has been supplied to the counsel for the petitioner during the course of hearing.
3. It is evident from the status report that the alleged detainee namely Sukhwinder Kaur @ Sukhnoor Kaur alongwith her child has returned back to her matrimonial house at Manjal Kanjal and started living with the petitioner.
4. In view of the above, nothing survives in the instant petition, as the same has been rendered infructuous.
5. Disposed off, having been rendered infructuous.
