Instant application has been filed for bringing on record the additional facts and for exemption from filing certified copy of Annexures A-1 to A-3.

Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.41 dated 15.06.2023, under Sections 379, 447, 511, 427 and 120-B IPC registered at P.S. Bhadson, Patiala.

Vide order dated 15.02.2024, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.



Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 15.02.2024, the petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Subhash Kumar, affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

Learned counsel for the respondent No.2/complainant opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner and stated that the petitioner does not deserve the concession of anticipatory bail.

In view of the above, interim order dated 15.02.2024 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
