1. This is a contempt petition filed under Article 215 of the Constitution of India read with Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 06.07.2017 passed by this Court in CWP-11876-2016.

2. Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and in view of the fact that the Assistant Collector has already passed the order in the litigation referred to in the order dated 06.07.2017, passed by this Court and challenging the said order, the petition i.e. CWP-22177-2022 is stated to have been filed by the petitioner, which is pending adjudication, this Court does not find it appropriate to interfere in the matter. Hence, the present contempt petition is dismissed.

3. However, dismissal of the present petition would have no effect on the rights of the petitioner in CWP-22177-2022, which is stated to be filed by the petitioner.
