1. This is a civil writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus seeking direction to respondents no.2 to 4 to allow the petitioner to sit in the written examination of NCC “C” certificate to be held on 09.02.2020.
2. Learned State counsel has stated that the written examination of NCC “C” certificate was to be held on 09.02.2020 and no interim order in favour of the petitioner was passed and thus, the present petition in all likelihood has been rendered infructuous.
3. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. Liberty is granted to the petitioner to revive the petition in case any cause survives.
