1. Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No.113 dated 27.12.2023, registered under Sections 61/1/14 of Punjab Excise Act, 1914, at Police Station Ladhuwal, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana.

2. Learned State counsel on instructions from police official submits that in compliance of order dated 09.02.2024, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for further investigation.

3. Having considered the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the petition is allowed. Order dated 09.02.2024 passed by this Court, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

4. Further, in case, the petitioner indulges himself in similar kind of activities in future, the Investigating Agency shall be duty bound to seek cancellation of his bail.
