1. There was no representation on behalf of the petitioners on the last date of hearing i.e. 22.07.2024. Today also the position is the same.

2. The petitioners have filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, claiming the following reliefs :-

“Issuance of an appropriate writ order or direction especially a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to pay the salary to the petitioners as the petitioners have been paid half of the salary from January, 2020 to August 2020, full Salary of September and no salary has been paid to the petitioners thereafter till today without any reason but probably because of the reason that the petitioners were placed under suspension due to their arrest on 22.01.2020 in FIR No. 194 dated 11.09.2019 but without appreciating the fact that the



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petitioners have been reinstated in services on 07.09.2020 and the petitioners have joined the services on 08.09.2020 and since than rendering the services to the respondents. Further, the petitioners have not been served any show cause notice, charge sheet nor any departmental proceedings are pending against the petitioners despite that no salary has been paid to the petitioners.”

3. Learned counsel for respondent No.3 submits that since the petitioners have been paid all the dues as have been claimed in the present petition, therefore, the instant petition has been rendered infructuous.

4. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for respondent No.3, the instant petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of accordingly.
