1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for punishing the respondents for disobeying order dated 29.01.2024 passed in CRM-3278-2024 in CRM-M-64928-2023.
2. Short reply by way of affidavit of Rashpal Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police (D), Fazilka, District Fazilka, filed in the Court today, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
3. Pursuant to the order dated 08.02.2024, respondent No.2- Rashpal Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police (D), Fazilka, District Fazilka, has appeared in the Court today. He has submitted that there was no intentional violation or non-compliance of the order dated 29.01.2024 passed in CRM-3278-2024 in CRM-M-64928-2023. In fact, he was never intimated about the aforesaid order dated 29.01.2024. He came to know about the same, only when he received the notice issued in the present

contempt petition. After getting the knowledge of the aforesaid order dated 29.01.2024, the petitioner has never been called by the respondent(s).

4. There is nothing on record to show that the order passed by this Court was ever communicated to the respondent(s), as such.

5. In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to continue with the present petition any more.

6. Dismissed.
