NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of certiorari/mandamus, quashing the impugned resolution No.5 dated 11.08.2000 of respondent No.1 promoting respondent No.3 from the post of clerk to Auction Recorder and directing respondent Nos.1 and 2 to consider and promote the petitioner as Auction Recorder with all consequential benefits.

2. On the last date of hearing i.e. 11.09.2024, the following order was passed:-

"As per office report, notice issued to Sh. Sharwan Sehgal, Advocate, counsel for the petitioner has been received back duly served.

Mr. Amit Kaith, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondent Nos.1 & 2 and seeks time to get further instructions from the

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department about the present status of the petitioner as well as respondent No.3 and as to whether the petitioner as well as respondent No.3 were further given promotion.

On his request, adjourned to 16.09.2024."

3. Learned counsel for respondent Nos.1 and 2 submits that during the pendency of the present petition, the petitioner has been promoted to the post of Auction Recorder in the year 2006 and has retired as such, in the year 2010.
4. There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.
5. In this view of the matter, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution with liberty to the petitioner to revive the same in case, any cause still survives.
