SURESHWAR THAKUR, J. (ORAL)

1. The learned Additional Advocate General representing the State of Haryana submits that since this Court has made an adjudication on 20.02.2024, upon, *Civil Writ Petition No.1620 of 2024*, whereby, this Court has permitted the learned Assistant Collector Concerned, seized with the ejectment petition concerned, to forthwith take up the said eviction petition, and, has also directed him to, within three months thereafter, make a lawful speaking decision thereons, but after hearing all affected persons concerned.
2. Therefore, he further submits that since the subject of the instant writ petition, is similar to the subject of writ petition (supra), thus, alike the orders passed in *Civil Writ Petition No.1620 of 2024*, rather orders be also passed on the instant writ petition. Therefore, paragraph No.11 of the said writ petition is extracted below:-

“11. In consequence, the learned Assistant Collector concerned seized with the ejectment petition concerned is directed to forthwith take up the said eviction petition and is also directed to within three months from

today make a lawful speaking decision thereons but after hearing all affected persons concerned.”

3. Ordered accordingly.
4. The writ petition is disposed of accordingly.
