Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the outset, submits that as per communication dated 02.12.2019 (Annexure R-1), Executive Engineer, Construction Division No.1 P.W.D. (B&R) Branch, Ludhiana has opined that NOC cannot be issued for the setting up of petrol pump at the proposed site. As per his information, the jurisdictional Deputy Commissioner has not issued NOC in terms of Rule 144 of Petroleum Rules, 2002, thus, at this stage, he does not press the present petition.
