1. Prayer in this application under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908, is for transfer of the petition filed by the respondent-husband under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, bearing No.HMA/297/2023, pending before the learned Principal Judge, Family Court, Pathankot, to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Hoshiarpur.
2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the notice received by the petitioner in the proceedings sought to be transferred, she did not put in appearance before the Family Court and was, thus, proceeded against *ex parte*. The petitioner has moved an application for setting aside the said *ex parte* proceedings, which is pending consideration.
3. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to file afresh after decision

of the aforesaid application.
