**RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)**

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 02.03.2023 passed in CWP-16533-2021.
2. Counsel for respondents No.2 and 3 has submitted that the order dated 02.03.2023 passed in CWP-16533-2021 has since been complied with and legal notice of the petitioner has been decided by passing the speaking order. Copy of the speaking order, produced by the counsel for respondents No.2 and 3 in the Court today, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
3. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, she would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
