This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a writ, order or direction for the grant of seniority to the petitioner from the date of his initial selection and appointment in 1986 for temporary Engineer on the recommendation of the Departmental Selection Committee and the offer of appointment made by the Governor of Punjab. Other prayers have also been made in the present writ petition.
2. Learned Senior Counsel for the petitioner has submitted in spite of best efforts, his office has not been able to get in touch with his client and in all probability, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous and the same may kindly be disposed of as such. It is however prayed that liberty be granted to the petitioner to move an application for restoration of the present case or to file a fresh petition, in case, any cause survives to him.
3. Accordingly, the present Civil Writ Petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
4. Liberty is granted to the petitioner to move an application for restoration of the present case or to file a fresh petition, in case, any cause survives to him.
5. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of in view of the abovesaid order.
