1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of certiorari, quashing the orders dated 03.02.1995 and 21.04.1999 (Annexures P-11 & P-15) passed by respondent No.2. Further, seeking a writ of mandamus, directing the respondents to allow the petitioner to join duty forthwith with all consequential benefits and to decide the appeal dated 08.07.1996 (Annexure P-12) filed by the petitioner afresh with a reasoned order.

2. Since there was no representation on behalf of the petitioner on 21.08.2024, therefore, notice was ordered to be issued to the petitioner, returnable on 15.10.2024.

3. As per office report, notice issued to the petitioner has not



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been received back served or otherwise and the matter was adjourned on 15.10.2024 for today for awaiting the service of the petitioner and in the meanwhile, respondent No.4 was directed to get instructions about the present status of the petitioner.

4. Learned counsel for respondent No.4 submits that the petitioner was dismissed from service in the year 1995 and they are not having any residential address of the petitioner.

5. In this view of the matter, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
