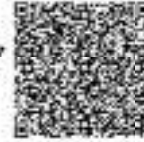

The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of Certiorari to set aside order dated 16.12.1999 (Annexure P-4) passed by the learned Divisional Canal Officer, Hisar Water Services Division, Hisar (respondent No.2 herein) and order dated 13.03.2000 (Annexure P-5) passed by the learned Superintending Canal Officer, Bhakra Water Services Circle-I, Hisar (respondent No.3 herein).

2. Today, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

3. Learned counsel for the State, while referring to order dated 16.12.1999 (Annexure P-4), submits that the matter pertains to restoration of

watercourse ABC falling in the middle of 110/2/2-3-4-5 and 110/6-7-8-9/1; which was restored for one year only. It is submitted that the said period of one year has already expired, accordingly, the instant writ petition has become infructuous.

3. Keeping in view the aforesaid submissions made by learned counsel for the State, the present writ petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of the present writ petition, in case any of his grievances still survives.

4. All pending application(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
