The prayer in the appeal is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.153 dated 31.12.2013 under Sections 3(1)(3)(x) of SC & ST Prevention of Atrocities Act, 1889 amended 2015 Police Station Amloh.

Learned Counsel for the appellant submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 12.02.2024 **passed** by this Court, appellant has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions submits that the appellant has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 12.02.2024 and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 12.02.2024 is made absolute.



However, the appellant shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
