Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for quashing of order dated 24.10.2016 (P-8) passed by learned Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gurugram, whereby, petitioner was declared proclaimed absconder (sic. offender) in FIR No.770 dated 20.09.2015, under Sections 201, 120-B, 302 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860; and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959; along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

2. After arguing for some time, when this Court was not inclined to accept the prayer, learned counsel, on instructions from petitioner, wishes to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to take recourse to the remedy available under law.

3. Ordered accordingly.

4. Needless to say that in case petitioner surrenders before learned trial Court within 01 week from today and moves an

application for bail, the same be considered expeditiously in accordance with law.
