1. Heard.

2. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner apprehending harassment at the instance of respondent No. 4, had been approaching the respondent authorities for redressal of his grievance but the police is not taking any action. He further submits that even a representation dated 30.12.2023 (Annexure P-3) has been moved to the Superintendent of Police Rewari (Haryana) but till date no action has been taken thereon.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that for the purpose of the present petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No. 2 to consider and dispose of the representation in accordance with the law in an expeditious manner.

4. Notice of motion to the official respondents.
5. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Surender Singh, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the State-respondents No. 1 to 3 and submits that the aforesaid representation dated 30.12.2023 will be decided in an expeditious manner according to law.
6. In the circumstances of the case and without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No. 2- the Superintendent of Police, Rewari, Haryana, to consider the averments made in the representation dated 30.12.2023 (Annexure P-3), to dispose of the same expeditiously and to take action, as warranted, under the provisions of the law.
7. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner.
