1. The petitioners have filed the instant writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of certiorari, quashing the proceedings dated 26.09.1996 (Annexure P-6 and P-7) of the Standing Committee, whereby respondents No.2 to 5 were ordered to be promoted and for quashing the action of the authorities in assigning the separate quota to AMIE/Degree Holder Junior Engineers for promotion to the post of Assistant Engineer (Civil).
2. Learned counsel for the parties submit that during the pendency of the present petition, the petitioners and the private respondents have retired from service on attaining the age of superannuation, therefore, with the efflux of time, the instant petition has been rendered infructuous.
