RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 20.01.2022 and 28.04.2021 passed in CWP-PIL-77-2021.

2. It is submitted by learned counsel for the respondents that the property of Mahender Singh, who was mortgagor and guarantor in the accounts of M/s Amritsar Cardiac & Implants Pharmacy, was sold by the PNB bank on 24.05.2023, only after the pandemic was over. Moreover, the said sale was done pursuant to the statutory provisions. Not only that, challenging the sale, the petitioner had filed an appeal before DRT-I, Chandigarh. The said appeal has already been dismissed on 17.10.2023.

3. In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to continue with the present petition any more.
