Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though, the present petition has been filed for the grant of regular bail to the petitioner, but petitioner will be satisfied in case, the trial Court is directed to conclude the trial in a time bound manner so that the petitioner does not suffer further incarceration, which is causing prejudice to him.

Learned State counsel raises no objection for the grant of the said prayer of the learned counsel for the petitioner but submits that petitioner be directed to cooperate in concluding the trial.

Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes that the petitioner will cooperate to conclude the trial in a time bound manner.

Keeping in view the above, present petition is disposed of with the direction to the trial Court to conclude the trial within a period of six

months from the next date of hearing, even if, the same is to be concluded by giving short adjournment or by passing coercive order for securing the presence of the witnesses.
