1. The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ of mandamus for directing respondent No.4 to allow him to join the duties at present place of posting and to direct the respondents to release the salary of the petitioner w.e.f 06.02.2001.

2. Learned counsel for respondent Nos.2 to 5 submits that during the pendency of the present petition, the petitioner has unfortunately died on 08.03.2010.

3. Perusal of the case file shows that the LRs of the deceased-petitioner have not been brought on record.

4. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution with liberty to the LRs of the deceased-petitioner to revive the same, in case anything still survives.
