1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of order dated 11.09.1997 whereby he was reverted to the post of Constable.
2. The petitioner joined Punjab Police as constable w.e.f. 31.03.1986. He worked during the period of terrorism and was granted C-II by DIG vide order dated 04.01.1989. He was promoted to the post of Head Constable vide order dated 12.11.1990. The petitioner by impugned order was reverted to the post of Constable.
3. Mr. Pawan Kumar, DAG, Punjab on instructions from ASI Amrik Singh, submits that petitioner, during the pendency of petition, was promoted to the post of Head Constable w.e.f. 18.03.2003 and thereafter he was further promoted to the post of ASI w.e.f. 13.01.2014.
4. In the wake of statement of learned State Counsel, the present petition stands disposed of as infructuous.

5. There is no representation on behalf of petitioner, thus, he is at liberty to move an appropriate application, if cause survives.
6. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
