JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J (ORAL)

1. The petitioners through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India are seeking setting aside of Award dated 16.04.1999 (Annexure P-1) whereby Labour Court has ordered to reinstate the workman with continuity of service and full back wages.
2. The petitioner is an instrumentality of State Government and respondent No. 2 is its ex-employee. The petitioners dismissed workman. He approached Labour Court which vide impugned Award dated 16.04.1999 ordered to reinstate him with continuity of service and back wages.
3. Counsel for the parties are *ad idem* that workman was reinstated in terms of orders passed by Labour Court and is still in service.

4. Counsel for respondent No. 2 submits that he does not press *qua* back wages, if his order of reinstatement is upheld.
5. Mr. Vikas Singh, Advocate expressed his inability to controvert prayer of the respondent.
6. In the wake of statement of both sides and considering the fact that workman is still working with the Management and was reinstated in terms of order passed by Labour Court, the impugned Award is modified to the extent that workman would not be entitled to back wages.
7. Disposed of.
8. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
