NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of certiorari, quashing/setting aside the charge-sheet dated 10.08.2000 (Annexure P-4) and order dated 11.09.2020 (Annexure P-6), whereby the Inquiry Officer was appointed.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that during the pendency of the present petition, the petitioner has been awarded the punishment of bringing him down by one stage in his time scale of pay for calculating his retiral dues and the said punishment has been set aside by the Appellate Authority vide order dated 29/31.05.2012 and nothing survives in the present petition. He, however, further submits that if any amount, including interest, is still due, he may be given



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liberty to make a representation to the competent authority and the same may be ordered to be disposed of in a time bound manner.

3. If any such representation is submitted by the petitioner within a period of 01 month from today, the same shall be considered and disposed of by the competent authority within a period of 03 months thereafter.

4. Disposed of in the above terms.

5. Pending application, if any, shall stands disposed of accordingly
