This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for disobedience of the order dated 10.08.2023 passed in CWP-17483-2023.

Reply by way of affidavit of respondent No.7 has been filed today in the Court. Learned counsel for respondent Nos.1 to 6 has filed copy of speaking order dated 06.03.2024. The same are taken on record. Registry is directed to scan the same and place it at appropriate place.

Learned counsel for the respondents have submitted that the order dated 10.08.2023 passed in CWP-17483-2023 has been complied with and speaking order dated 05/06.03.2024 have been passed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the same.

In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.

However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-addressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
