The prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.34 dated 01.06.2022 under Sections 419, 420, 120-B IPC and Section 66D of I.T. Act registered at P.S. Cyber, District Gurugram.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 18.03.2024 **passed** by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 18.03.2024 and are not required for custodial interrogation.

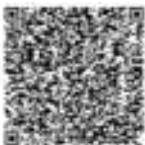
In this view of the matter, interim order dated 18.03.2024 is made absolute.
