The present writ petition has been filed under Section 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus, seeking appointment of a Warrant Officer to get released or produce alleged detenues namely, Rishipal S/o Nakli and Kela W/o Rishipal, who are alleged to be in illegal custody of respondents No.5 to 11.

Vide order dated 07.02.2024, passed by this Court, a Warrant Officer had been appointed and he had submitted a report dated 08.02.2024. As per the said report the custody of the alleged detenues namely, Rishipal S/o Nakli and Kela W/o Rishipal have already been handed over to the petitioner and they have left the police station on their own.

On the other hand learned State counsel submits that both the parties have arrived at a settlement with regard to the dispute pending between them.

In view of the detailed report submitted by the Warrant Officer as well as learned State counsel, no further directions are required and the present petition is accordingly disposed off.
