1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order passed by respondent No.1, whereby the detailed representation/notice submitted by the petitioner has been rejected and further seeking a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to promote the petitioner from the date his juniors have been promoted.
2. Since there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner on 15.10.2019 and 13.11.2019, therefore, notice was ordered to be issued to the petitioner.
3. As per office report, notice issued to the petitioner has been received back unserved with the report “not residing in the village”.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution with liberty to the petitioner for revival of the same in case anything still survives.
