VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

1. Present Civil Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to protect the pay of the petitioners.
2. Learned State counsel has submitted that the present matter pertains to the year 1998 and the present petition, in all probability, has been rendered infructuous.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that inspite of the best efforts, office of the counsel for the petitioners has not been able to get in touch with the petitioners and hence, he prays that the present petition may be dismissed for non-prosecution at this stage but liberty may be granted to the petitioners to revive the petition, in case, any cause of action survives.

4. In view of the above facts and circumstances, present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution with the aforesaid liberty.
