Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.355 dated 28.10.2020 registered under Section 132 of Central Goods and Services Tax Act (CGST), 2017 and Sections 406, 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of IPC (Section 409 of IPC added later on) at Police Station Civil Line, District Sirsa.

2. Petitioner was granted interim bail with direction to join investigation by this Court vide order dated 14.02.2024.
3. Today, counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner apprised the Court that in compliance of the aforesaid order petitioner has joined investigation with the police.
4. Reply by way of an affidavit of Jagat Singh, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Headquarter Sirsa, District Sirsa filed on behalf of State is taken on record along with Annexure R-1.

5. State counsel on instructions from ASI Abhay Ram submits that petitioner who has joined investigation with the police is no more required by the police for any further investigation or custodial interrogation in the present case.

6. In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 14.02.2024 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
