1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 13.10.2023 passed in RSA-1538-1999.
2. Perusal of the order, qua which the contempt is alleged, shows that all the pensionary benefits have already been granted to the petitioner herein.
3. In view of the above, this Court does not find any reason or ground to proceed further in the contempt petition, as such.
4. Dismissed.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-addressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
