ARUN MONGA, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner has, *inter alia*, questioned the legality and propriety of orders dated 16.10.1995 vide which the Arbitrator rejected the reference made by the petitioner Society for recovery of losses caused to it to the tune of Rs.96,297.60 ps by respondent No.4.

None has appeared on behalf of the petitioner. Similar was the position on the last date of hearing.

In view of the aforesaid, without expressing any opinion on the merits, *suffice* to say that by sheer pendency of the writ petition over past 22 years, it does seem that either the relief sought by the petitioner has been rendered infructuous or the petitioner has otherwise lost interest in prosecuting the present petition.

Writ petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous with liberty to the petitioner to file appropriate application, if so advised, in case any cause of action still survives.
