SANDEEP MOUDGIL, J (ORAL)

1. The jurisdiction of this Court under Section 438 Cr.P.C., has been invoked for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 443, dated 30.10.2021, under Sections 324, 34 and 506 IPC and Section 3 of SC & ST Act, 1989 (Section 307 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Agroha, Hisar.
2. It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that earlier the petitioner has been granted the interim bail vide order dated 14.09.2021, which was made absolute later on vide order dated 19.12.2022. It is further submitted that the petitioner has been regularly attending the trial Court and he has filed an application for exemption from personal appearance before the court concerned on 01.02.2024, which was dismissed by it finding no ground. The non-appearance of the petitioner is neither intentional nor deliberate.
3. Notice of motion.
4. At the asking of Court, Mr. Baljinder Singh Virk, Sr. DAG, Haryana, who is appearing on advance notice, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State of

Haryana. He prays for dismissal of the present petition stating that the petitioner is a bail jumper.

5. Be that as it may, considering the fact that the non-appearance of the petitioner was neither willful nor deliberate, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the trial Court who shall released him on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal/surety bond to its satisfaction.

6. Disposed off, accordingly.
