1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for quashing of FIR No.266 dated 02.08.2017 registered under Sections 406 and 498-A read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 in Police Station Women Police Station Gurugram, District Gurugram and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of an affidavit dated 17.02.2021.

2. Learned State counsel has informed that after completion of investigation, final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has been presented in the Court of the learned Illaqa Magistrate, Gurugram on 28.10.2017. Charges were framed against the petitioner under Sections 498-A, 406, 34 IPC on 06.01.2018. There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner. Even on 16.08.2022 and 29.11.2022, there was no representation on behalf of the petitioner. On 29.11.2022 last opportunity was granted to the petitioner for appearance and following order was passed:-

“None has appeared on behalf of the petitioner, despite pass over. Same was the position on the previous date of hearing.

In the interest of justice, adjourned to 06.03.2023.

However, it is made clear that in the event none appears on the adjourned date, appropriate orders for final disposal of the main petition shall be passed.”

3. Even today there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

It appears that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the present petition.

4. As such, the present petition stands dismissed for non-prosecution.
