Main case

1. The present petition has been filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondent for disobeying and disregarding the order dated 19.02.2021 passed by the State Registrar of Societies, Haryana as also the order dated 05.07.2022 passed by the Registrar General of Societies, Haryana.

2. Perusal of the file shows that the order qua which contempt is alleged has been passed by the Registrar General of Societies, Haryana. However, the said administrative authority does not fall within the scope of 'Subordinate Court' by any means. Therefore, the present contempt petition is liable to be dismissed.

3. Ordered accordingly.

4. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail any other remedy, but in accordance with law.
