1. Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned charge-sheet (Annexure P-3) issued to the petitioner as on the same facts and allegation a case bearing FIR No.16 dated 19.09.2019 (Annexure P-1), registered at Police Station State Vigilance Bureau, Hisar, under Section 7 of the Prevention and Corruption Act, 1988 is pending.
2. Learned State counsel has submitted that in the present writ petition, the criminal proceedings have been culminated and the petitioner has been convicted in FIR No.16 dated 19.09.2019 (Annexure P-1) and thus, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has not disputed the said fact.
4. Keeping in view the above-said facts and circumstances, the present writ petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
