1. The jurisdiction of this Court under Section 482 Cr.P.C., has been invoked for directing respondents No.2 to 5 to take action on the e-mail dated 28.01.2024 (Annexure P-2) sent by the petitioner to respondent No.3.
2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.3 to decide the complaint dated 28.01.2024 submitted by the petitioner through e-mail in a time bound manner.
3. Notice to the official respondents only at this state.
4. At the asking of Court, Mr. Baljinder Singh Virk, Sr. DAG, Haryana, who is appearing on advance notice, accepts the same on behalf of respondent-State of Haryana. Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to supply requisite copies of the petition to learned State counsel during the course of day.
5. With commenting upon the merits of the case, respondent No.3- Commissioner of Police, Faridabad is directed to look into the grievances unfolded

by the petitioner in his complaint dated 28.01.2024 (Annexure P-2) and to decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

6. In view of the afore-said terms, the present petition is disposed off.
