1. The instant petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. has been filed by the petitioner for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to take action on the representation filed by the petitioner (Annexure P-2) for not harassing the petitioner on pretext of getting information about his son, who is already disowned by the petitioner.

2. It is, *inter alia*, contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is being harassed by the officials of P.S. Jandiala, Amritsar, Punjab and P.S. Sadar Amritsar, Punjab, who want to know about the whereabouts of his son Ajaypal Singh, whom the petitioner has already disowned. For seeking protection from such harassment, the petitioner had moved representation dated 01.02.2024 (Annexure P-2) to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar Rural, but till date no action thereon has been taken. He submits that the petitioner will be satisfied if appropriate directions are given to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar Rural, to consider and dispose of

the representation dated 01.02.2024 (Annexure P-2) in accordance with law in an expeditious manner.

3. Notice of motion.
4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Harpreet Singh, Addl. A.G., Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.
5. After hearing the respective submissions and also the averments made in the petition by learned counsel for the petitioner, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar Rural, to consider and dispose of the representation dated 01.02.2024 (Annexure P-2) moved by the petitioner in accordance with law in an expeditious manner and the decision so taken be also intimated to the petitioner as well.
6. Disposed of.
