Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of appropriate order or direction to the official respondents to conduct the medical of petitioner No.2 as petitioner No.2 is a rape victim as despite filing the applications/representations (Annexures P/1 to P/3) in this regard, till date no steps have been taken to conduct the medical of petitioner No.2 by the official respondents.
