1. By way of present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., the petitioner is seeking direction to the official respondents No.2 and 3 to conduct fair and impartial investigation in case bearing FIR No.235 dated 17.11.2023 (Annexure P-1).
2. It is, *inter alia*, contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that an FIR bearing No.235 dated 17.11.2023 (Annexure P-1) was got registered by the petitioner against the accused but after the registration of the FIR, no action has been taken by the police on the same and in this regard he has moved representation (Annexure P-2) to respondent No.2 on 03.01.2024 but despite that no action has been taken. Hence, the petition.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that for the purpose of this petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if appropriate directions are given to respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar Rural, District Amritsar to consider and dispose of the

representation (Annexure P-2) dated 03.01.2024 in accordance with law in an expeditious manner.

- 4. Notice of motion.
- 5. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Harpreet Singh, Addl. AG, Punjab, present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State-respondents.
- 6. After hearing the respective submissions and also the averments made in the petition by learned counsel for the petitioner, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed with a direction to respondent No.2 - Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar Rural, District Amritsar to consider and dispose of the representation dated 03.01.2024 (Annexure P-2) moved by the petitioner in accordance with law in an expeditious manner and the decision so taken be also intimated to the petitioner as well.
- 7. Decision so taken be intimated to the petitioner.
- 8. Disposed of.
