The petitioners are seeking to quash the FIR No. 92 dated 08.08.2021 under Sections 323, 34, 406, 498-A IPC, registered at Police Station Women, Faridabad on the basis of compromise.

The case has been called twice. Even after lunch there is no representation on behalf of the petitioners.

As per order dated 05.10.2023 passed by the Co-ordinate Bench, parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate on 17.10.2023 for recording the statements. However, the parties did not appear. On 13.12.2023, parties were given another opportunity to appear before the trial Court and following order was passed:

“ xxx Parties are directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate for recording of their respective statements on or before 10.01.2024 subject to payment of Rs.5,000/- each to the High Court Legal Service Committee. However, statement of respondent No.2 namely Roshmin Ramesan, who is stated to be residing in Canada be also recorded through video conferencing subject to identification through Special Power of Attorney and

trial Court shall also ensure calling for the identification documents of respondent No.2 through e-mail or otherwise.”

As per the report of the learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Faridabad dated 10.01.2024, neither the complainant nor the accused appeared for recording their statements.

It appears that the petitioners are not interested in pursuing the present petition.

Dismissed for non-prosecution.
